

Veteran accounting firm recommends Adagio Ledger

No learning curve and no conversion draws G. Ross McDonald to Adagio

G. Ross McDonald is an accounting firm in Vancouver, Canada with over twenty years of experience. They specialize in providing accounting services to small private and public companies, but they also provide personal tax services for their clients.



Many small companies in Vancouver like to do their own bookkeeping while Sandra Lim at G. Ross McDonald takes care of their accounting. That means that Sandra has to work with many different accounting platforms to

conform with programs that her clients use. The long list of installed programs at G. Ross McDonald includes ACCPAC Plus, Simply Accounting and Intuit's QuickBooks. But now Adagio Ledger has been added to this list, and Sandra recommends it to clients looking for a Windows-based general ledger.

Adagio Ledger has the most intuitive interface so that all tasks in the program are completed using similar streamlined steps. Sandra said she finds Adagio Ledger "very easy to use."

There was also an extra advantage that Sandra found for the G. Ross McDonald firm: The Adagio programs require no data conversion from ACCPAC Plus. "A main reason we chose Adagio Ledger was that there was no time spent on conversion," Sandra said.

But it was doubly helpful because she has to work with data from clients that use different accounting platforms, including ACCPAC Plus. Now Sandra can work with clients' data in Adagio Ledger even when the client uses ACCPAC Plus. This is possible because the Adagio products work directly on ACCPAC Plus data.

One of Sandra's favorite features in Adagio Ledger is the Audit Trail feature. "Adagio Ledger has a good audit trail. We do many audits for clients," Sandra explained, "and many of the smaller accounting programs that these clients use don't have audit trail features."



Now that Sandra uses Adagio Ledger, she has recommended the program to one of her own clients. "Just after it was installed here, a client called and asked me if I knew anything about Adagio." Sandra gave the client her Adagio demo CD and highly recommended the program.
