Adagio OrderEntry is for companies that must MANAGE orders — future orders, standing orders and back orders. Used with a price list, or online integration with Adagio Inventory, Adagio OrderEntry easily controls partial shipments and allows companies to conveniently allocate inventory to their clients.

## Adagio Time&Billing

The new Adagio Time&Billing module is especially designed for companies that bill time. Using a batch based timesheet entry model, Adagio Time&Billing controls WIP, progress billing, write-ups and write downs and staff productivity to allow companies to closely manage contracts. Packaged with Softrak's TimeKeeper module, Adagio Time&Billing allows desk bound consultants to use their computer to track project time and automatically create a batch with time and disbursement entries. Adagio Time&Billing should be considered when companies have a need to re-bill disbursements (with its direct integration to Accounts Payable) or manage WIP. Adagio Time&Billing is ideal for architects, engineers, accountants and other consulting professions.

## Combinations
